Duna Rolando quoted Arthur Schnitzler (1862 - 1931, Austrian playwright and narrator) in her catalog:

"The desire is that which nourishes our soul and not the performance. And the purpose of life is the journey, not the destination. Because every answer is deceptive, every fulfillment melts between our hands, and the goal is no longer a goal, once it has been achieved. "

The paintings currently on display belong to the series "Family Album".
"Family Album" are portraits of the artist's family from Buenos Aires, mainly from the 60s .
The dignity of unknown people is recognized by Duna Rolando through the painted portrait.
